Bell Training

- use a 3m hook to place bell on a ribbon or string next to the door
- do not place on the door handle because you will get accustomed to hearing the bells
- bell training can take a couple days or a week or more depending on the dog
 - be consistent and have your dog ring the bell before going out every time
- in order to get your dog interested in the bell hold the string with the bells in one hand and then a treat in the other
- place the treat behind the bell and have your dogs nose touch the bell as it tries to go through to the treat
 - soon as the nose touches the bell give the dog a treat and take outside to go potty
 - continue this every time your dog goes outside
- as your dog gets use to this try placing the bell on the wall or its designated spot and have the dog tap it with its nose from there
- your dog should start to catch on as long as your consistent and you can gradually take away the treats
- use these instructions along with the potty training instructions
